



2019 Tempranillo

Vineyard:

We source this fruit from a well-established grower in Oregon's Rogue Valley AVA who has received and maintains the LIVE and Salmon-Safe designation.

Vintage:

A mild summer and cool, rainy, harvest season made 2019 reminiscent of decades past when such conditions were the norm. Classic cool-climate flavor profiles resulted.

Winemaking:

Fruit was destemmed with minimal crushing then fermented in small bins. After pressing and malolactic fermentation, the wine was aged in 30% new French, Hungarian, and Czechoslovakian barrels for 30 months.

Tasting Notes:

Dense and chewy with notes of black currant, plum, cedar, and cocoa.
