



2021 Riesling

Vineyard:

The fruit was sourced from Andreas Vineyard, our LIVE Certified Sustainable estate vineyard in the Van Duzer Corridor sub-AVA of the Willamette Valley. Well-drained Bellpine and Jory silty clay loam volcanic soils and moderate slopes with southern exposure make for outstanding cool-climate winegrowing.

Vintage:

2021 was a banner year in the Willamette Valley. Yields were slightly below average, but fruit quality was outstanding thanks to a warm summer and moderate, sunny harvest season.

Winemaking:

Fruit was hand picked and immediately whole-cluster pressed. Fermentation was conducted in stainless steel tanks at 55-60°F.

Tasting Notes:

Bright citrus, fruity pebble, and pear notes on the nose and palate are accented by floral and petrol aromas characteristic of the Riesling grape.
