



## Fireside Port

### **Vineyard:**

The fruit was sourced from Andreas Vineyard, our LIVE Certified Sustainable estate vineyard in the Van Duzer Corridor sub-AVA of the Willamette Valley. Well-drained Bellpine and Jory silty clay loam soils and moderate slopes with southern exposure make for outstanding cool-climate winegrowing. Elevation: 600-800 feet.

### **Winemaking:**

Marechal Foch, Cascade, and Pinot Noir grapes were fermented in stainless steel tanks until the desired amount of sugar remained in the must. The fermentation was arrested by the addition of high proof neutral brandy. The wine was then aged for 18 months in neutral barrels.

Blackberry jam, figs, dark chocolate, cherry syrup, cedar.
