



2018 Pinot Noir

- Vineyard:** The fruit was sourced from Andreas Vineyard, our LIVE Certified Sustainable estate vineyard in the Van Duzer Corridor sub-AVA of the Willamette Valley. Well-drained Bellpine and Jory silty clay loam volcanic soils and moderate slopes with southern exposure make for outstanding cool-climate winegrowing.
- Vintage:** 2018 brought consistent warmth and even ripening. A relatively dry harvest season allowed for picking of pristine fruit with ripe flavors and well developed phenolics.
- Winemaking:** Fruit was destemmed with minimal crushing then fermented in small bins. After pressing and malolactic fermentation, the wine was aged in 30% new French, Hungarian, and Czechoslovakian barrels for 30 months.
- Tasting Notes:** Well structure for aging, this muscular Pinot Noir features licorice and blackberry notes wrapped around a warm core of cherry cola.
