



2021 Pinot Gris

Vineyard:

The fruit was sourced from Andreas Vineyard, our LIVE Certified Sustainable estate vineyard in the Van Duzer Corridor sub-AVA of the Willamette Valley. Well-drained Bellpine silty clay loam marine sedimentary soils and moderate slopes with southern exposure make for outstanding cool-climate winegrowing. Elevation 650-750 feet.

Vintage:

2021 was a banner year in the Willamette Valley. Yields were slightly below average, but fruit quality was outstanding thanks to a warm summer and moderate, sunny harvest season.

Winemaking:

Fruit was hand picked and immediately whole-cluster pressed. Fermentation was conducted in stainless steel tanks at 55-60°F over the course of 6 weeks.

Tasting Notes:

Juicy pear, Honeycrisp apple, and kiwi. Plush, round, fruity, and refreshingly balanced.
